On April 30th our house and seven others burned to the ground. No one was injured or killed. It is true that the bible says in James 1 “whenever” we face trials not “if” We have been called to walk “through” (Is 43:2) not “around” or “over.” Continuing on was so hard but was the right thing to do. Every step had to be from God’s direction and His grace because even doing simple things like eating and sleeping were hard. The love, support, and immediate response from family and friends was like air to a drowning victim. Many people on the other side of the world stayed up and cried all night and prayed for us. We were already scheduled to leave in two months for a medical sabbatical after 12 years in the field. When the fire happened we were tempted to leave early. Feelings and truth rarely line up, and in this case they were standing on opposite poles. We decided to do more than ever with the time we had left and to fight our carnal reaction. With lots of help and grace we finished strong.

8. Starting working on rebuilding the 9 houses that burned down (one was added that burned down last year). And the work is still continuing as you read this newsletter.
9. Continued bible studies and preaching and giving medical advice. Even though we are not there now, the work and support continues. We are in contact every other day and still supporting families, students, and ministries that we have raised up. There are even reports of spiritual great grandchildren now. God is amazing.
